- No later than execution of PFA

2. **Submittal for Provisional Review**

- When – Completion of CDs (preferably prior commencement of construction)
- No later than “Notice to Proceed”

3. **Submittal for Final Review**

- When – Within 90 days of substantial completion
- No later than final completion
- Required for closeout – Final Audit cannot be completed
