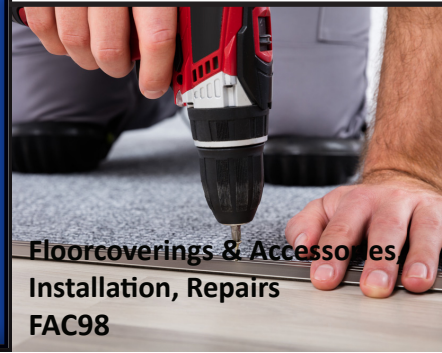

State Surplus Property Program

The State Surplus Property Office (SSPO) is here to help! The SSPO manages the disposal, transfer, and sale of all State-owned surplus personal property. Surplus property includes, but is not limited to: office equipment and furniture, clothing, vehicles, and materials that exceed agency need.

For budget-conscious school systems, the SSPO may be of great assistance! After 30 days, any surplus property not transferred to Executive Departments is offered to municipalities, including schools, which may acquire the item for a small administrative fee.

If you are in need of an item, simply peruse the [Current Surplus Property Listing](#). If you see anything of interest, follow the directions on the listing and email the SSPO. New-to-you equipment and supplies are just a few clicks away!
