That the Executive Director be authorized to enter into a Project Scope and Budget Agreement and a Project Funding Agreement with the Athol-Royalston Regional School District to replace the Riverbend Elementary School with a new PK-4 facility located on a new site adjacent to the existing Pleasant Street Elementary School and the Athol-Royalston Middle School.

¹ The MSBA has provisionally included two (2) incentive points for energy efficiency, subject to the District meeting certain sustainability requirements for the project. If, however, the District does not qualify for these incentive points, its reimbursement rate of 80% will not be affected because the District’s rate will still be at the statutory maximum reimbursement rate of 80% with the addition of the 1.38 incentive reimbursement points for maintenance to the District’s base reimbursement rate of 78.95%.

² By statute, 80% is the maximum reimbursement rate.

Discussion

MSBA staff reviewed the documents provided by the District and met with the District and its consultants to discuss scope and budget. The District has provided a Total Project Budget of \$43,931,363, which includes an estimated construction cost of \$35,191,363 (\$368/sf). The basis of the Estimated Maximum Total Facilities Grant would be \$32,514,525, which excludes legal fees, site costs in excess of 8% of total building cost, cost associated ineligible administrative square footage, owner’s and construction contingency costs, cost associated with mailing and moving, and FF&E costs in excess of the \$2,400 per student allowance.

The MSBA does not anticipate that the District will expend all of its contingency funds on expenses that are eligible for MSBA reimbursement.

MSBA staff recommends an Estimated Maximum Total Facilities Grant of \$26,011,620, however, the District may be eligible for up to an additional \$1,640,000 in grant funds, subject to the MSBA's review and audit of the District's owner's and construction contingency expenditures. Accordingly, staff recommends a Maximum Total Facilities Grant of \$27,651,620 for the Project Scope and Budget Agreement and Project Funding Agreement for replacement of the Riverbend Elementary School with a new PK-4 facility located on a new site adjacent to the existing Pleasant Street Elementary School and the Athol-Royalston Middle School.
