Discussion

The OPM and Designer conducted a feasibility analysis of the facility and developed a Schematic Design including a proposed scope of work, schedule, and estimated budget. The District's Designer, Next Phase Studios, recommends window/door replacement at the Tantasqua Regional Junior High School. The Designer has confirmed that the window/door replacement will be in compliance with the MSBA's sustainability requirements.

MSBA staff reviewed the consultants' existing conditions analysis and proposed schedule that were provided by the District. Also, MSBA staff discussed the scope and budget with

the District and its consultants. The District has provided a Total Project Budget of \$2,000,000 which includes a construction cost of \$1,542,752. Construction costs include:

- \$899,223 (\$156.88/sf) for demolition of existing windows and installation of new windows;
- \$186,249 for installation of door frames and hardware (metal and aluminum storefront);
- \$176,036 for abatement;
- \$58,353 for security access control system;
- \$46,590 for wood blocking;
- \$45,002 for sheet metal flashing;
- \$20,317 for accessibility work at bathrooms and entrances
- and \$110,982 for associated project costs.

MSBA staff recommends an Estimated Maximum Total Facilities Grant of \$1,034,171; however, the District may be eligible for up to an additional \$42,912 in grant funds, subject to the MSBA's review and audit of the District's Owner's and Construction Contingency Expenditures. Accordingly, staff recommends a Maximum Total Facilities Grant of \$1,077,083 for the window/door replacement project at the Tantasqua Regional Junior High School.
