Discussion

MSBA staff reviewed the documents provided by the District and met with the District and its consultants to discuss scope and budget. The District has provided a Total Project Budget of \$177,460,652, which includes an estimated construction cost of \$147,537,913 (\$769/sq. ft.). The Estimated Basis of Total Facilities Grant would be \$130,715,587, which excludes OPM and Designer fees associated with ineligible square footage, OPM and Designer fees beyond MSBA funding limits, costs associated with legal fees, construction costs beyond MSBA funding limits plus eligible demolition and abatement, costs associated with abatement of asbestoscontaining floor material and ceiling tiles, costs associated with removal of underground storage fuel tanks, costs associated with mailing and moving, costs in excess of \$1,200 per student allowance for fixtures, furniture, and equipment, costs in excess of the \$1,200 per student allowance for technology, costs associated with the commissioning of ineligible building area, and owner's and construction contingency costs.

MSBA staff recommends an Estimated Maximum Total Facilities Grant of \$80,967,085; however, the District may be eligible for up to an additional \$1,370,996 in grant funds, subject to the MSBA's review and audit of the District's owner's and construction contingency expenditures. Accordingly, staff recommends a Maximum Total Facilities Grant of \$82,338,081 for the Project Scope and Budget Agreement and Project Funding Agreement to replace the existing East Longmeadow High School with a new facility serving grades 9-12 on the site of the existing school.

²Does not include any grant funds for potentially eligible Owner's or Construction Contingency Expenditures; subject to MSBA review and audit.

³Includes maximum possible Owner's and Construction Contingency grant funds, the final amount of which, if any, shall be determined by the MSBA in its sole discretion. The MSBA does not anticipate that the District will expend all of its contingency funds on expenses that are eligible for MSBA reimbursement.
