Discussion

The OPM and Designer conducted a feasibility analysis of the facility and developed a Schematic Design including a proposed scope of work, schedule, and estimated budget. The District's Designer, Shekar & Associates, Inc., recommends boiler replacement at the Harold L. Qualters Middle School. The Designer has confirmed that the boiler replacement will be in compliance with the MSBA's sustainability requirements.

MSBA staff reviewed the consultants' existing conditions analysis and proposed schedule that were provided by the District. Also, MSBA staff discussed the scope and budget with the District and its consultants. The District has provided a Total Project Budget of \$3,968,800, which includes a construction cost of \$3,180,377. Construction costs include:

- \$2,059,112 for the installation of six boilers (gas-fired boilers, 2513 MBH each);
- \$239,154 for associated boiler demolition and hazardous material abatement;
- \$135,546 for hot water tank replacement work;
- \$148,519 for associated HVAC work;
- \$268,154 for associated electrical work;
- \$183,426 for other associated work;
- and \$146,466 for associated compliance upgrades.

MSBA staff recommends the Estimated Total Facilities Grant and the Maximum Total Facilities Grant set forth in the table below subject to MSBA approval and audit:
