
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CAPITAL PIPELINE OVERVIEW

Status of Current Projects

A total of 307 projects that have received invitations from the Board of Directors ("Board") to collaborate with the Massachusetts School Building Authority ("MSBA") are currently in the MSBA's Eligibility Period and Capital Pipeline. The summary chart provides the number of projects in Eligibility Period and each phase of the Capital Pipeline. Compared to the prior Project Overview Report, the project total has increased by 28 projects to reflect invitations to the Accelerated Repair Program at the October 27, 2021 Board of Directors meeting. Capital Planning Updates:

The following activities are scheduled for FY 2022:

- Model School Program Five responses were received on October 31, 2019 and evaluated by the selection committee. Site visits occurred at two of the schools prior to school closures. The selection committee reconvened in January 2021 to complete the evaluation of the two applicants resulting in the approval of two new model schools at the February 11, 2021 Board of Directors meeting. To allow for additional responses, the Model School Request for Qualifications was re-advertised on February 24, 2021 and an informational meeting was held on March 30, 2021. Eight responses were received on May 26, 2021 and evaluated by the selection committee. Site visits to all eight schools as well as the three remaining from the previous procurement were conducted in August 2021 and presented to the Facilities Assessment Subcommittee in September 2021, resulting in the approval of six new Model School designs at the October 27, 2021 Board of Directors meeting.

2021 Progress Report

- Statements of Interest 2021
 - The 2021 SOI submittal period opened on April 20, 2021. The deadline to file for consideration in the Accelerated Repair Program was June 1, 2021 while the deadline to file for consideration in the Core Program was June 25, 2021. Recommendations for invitation to the Accelerated

Repair Program occurred at the October 27, 2021 Board of Directors meeting. Recommendations for invitation to the Core Program are anticipated at the March 2, 2022 Board of Directors meeting.

* Eligibility Period – Core Program

The 15 2020 SOIs are currently in the Eligibility Period following their invitations at the April 14,
 2021 Board of Directors meeting.

* Feasibility Study/Schematic Design – Core Program

- No districts completed their Owner's Project Manager ("OPM") selection since the last report and four districts are tentatively scheduled to receive MSBA approval for selection of their OPM.
- Three districts completed Designer selection since the last report and two districts are in the process of procuring a Designer.
- Five districts are anticipating submittals for their Preferred Schematic Solutions between December 2021 and April 2022.
- Five districts are anticipating submittals for their Project Scope and Budget Agreement authorizations between December 2021 and April 2022.

* Accelerated Repair Program

All 18 districts from the 2020 ARP invitations have received consultant assignments. 13 districts received project funding agreement approval through the October 27, 2021 Board of Directors meeting. Four of the remaining five districts are anticipating project funding agreement approval no later than the March 2, 2022 Board of Directors meeting. The fifth district will be removed from the Capital Pipeline at the December 15, 2021 Board of Directors meeting.

* Construction Costs - Core Program

 In 2021, 12 projects are scheduled to receive sub-bids. MSBA staff anticipates DBB bids or GMP executions for the 12 projects in 2021.

* Substantial Completion – Core Program

 18 projects are scheduled to reach substantial completion in 2021. The MSBA has received executed certificates for 15 of the 18 projects and anticipates receipt of three additional certificates.

STATEMENTS OF INTEREST (SOIs)

2021 SOI Process

The 2021 SOI submittal period opened on April 20, 2021. The deadline to file SOIs for consideration into the Accelerated Repair Program ("ARP"), which is primarily for the replacement of roofs, windows/doors, and/or boilers in an otherwise structurally sound facility was June 1, 2021. The MSBA received 60 ARP SOIs for consideration from 26 districts. The deadline to file SOIs for consideration into the Core Program, which is primarily for projects beyond the scope of ARP, including extensive repairs, renovations, additions/renovations, and new school construction, was June 25, 2021. The MSBA received 58 Core SOIs for consideration from 47 districts.

The MSBA received 60 ARP SOIs for consideration from 26 districts. The MSBA's due diligence for the ARP included site visits for 29 of the qualifying schools from 16 districts in August 2021. Invitations to the 2021 ARP occurred at the October 27, 2021 Board of Directors meeting. The MSBA received 58 Core Program SOIs for consideration. Staff are continuing with the due diligence process. Further review recommendations for senior study candidates were presented at the September 22, 2021 Facilities Assessment Subcommittee meeting and invitations into Eligibility Period are anticipated at the March 2, 2022 Board meeting.

CORE PROGRAM

ELIGIBILITY PERIOD

There are 15 districts in the Eligibility Period and eight of those districts have secured their local funding.

An agreed-upon enrollment is a key pre-requisite for the MSBA to commence a Feasibility Study with a district. To begin the enrollment projection process, a district must file enrollment information utilizing the MSBA's online enrollment projection tool.

CONSULTANT SELECTION

Owner's Project Manager Selection

After the district has completed all Eligibility Period requirements and has received a Board Invitation to Feasibility Study, the district procures an OPM. Since the last report, no districts completed their Owner's Project Manager ("OPM") selection. Currently, there are four districts in the Capital Pipeline in the process of procuring an OPM.

Designer Selection

After a district has selected and executed a contract with an OPM, the district selects a Designer by utilizing either a local designer selection process for projects under \$5 million or the MSBA's Designer Selection Panel ("DSP") for projects over \$5 million. Since the last report, three districts have completed their Designer selection. There are currently two districts in the Capital Pipeline that are in the process of procuring a Designer.

FEASIBILITY STUDY

Once a district has procured an OPM and a Designer, the district and the district's consultants must complete two Feasibility Study submittals, the Preliminary Design Program, and the Preferred Schematic Report, prior to Board consideration to proceed into Schematic Design. Based on the most recent data and schedules provided to the MSBA by districts, the MSBA anticipates that five districts will appear before the Board for their Preferred Schematic Design authorizations at the December 2021, March 2022, and April 2022 Board meetings.

To date, the MSBA has executed 560 commissioning consultant contracts, totaling \$42.4 million in commissioning fees, for 758 projects at 642 schools, many of whom have been invited to the Capital Pipeline multiple times. Construction budgets for projects being commissioned total \$13.5 billion. To date, 417 work orders have been completed.

DESIGN DEVELOPMENT

After a district has secured local funding and has entered into a Project Funding Agreement ("PFA") with the MSBA, the district enters the Design Development Phase. Currently, there are 19 projects in the Design Development Phase with a total estimated construction cost of approximately \$1.28 billion. Of those 19 projects, four are ARP Projects and 15 are Core Program Projects. The 15 Core Program Projects in Design Development have a total estimated construction cost of approximately \$1.27 billion and are listed below.





The graph below plots Schematic Design Construction Estimates and Construction Bid Results for new construction projects from October 2018 to present. The projects are presented based on their dates of DBB bids or GMP executions. The graph includes nine new construction projects in FY 2019, eleven new construction projects in FY 2020, 17 new construction projects in FY 2021, and three new construction projects in FY 2022. The Orange Line is a trend line for Bid Costs and the Blue Line is a trend line for Schematic Design Construction Estimates. Springfield has been added since the last report prepared for the October 27, 2021 Board of Directors meeting. Bid results for Springfield were within the estimated construction budget.

There were no addition/renovation projects in FY 2019. The Purple Line is a trend line for Bid Costs and the Yellow Line is a trend line for Schematic Design Estimates. There have been no new projects added since the last Project Overview Report prepared for the October 27, 2021 Board of Directors meeting.

CONSTRUCTION

When a district with a Design-Bid-Build Construction project issues a Notice to Proceed, or when a Construction Manager At-Risk project has received bids for the concrete foundation package, the project is advanced to the Construction Phase. Currently, there are 49 projects in the Construction Phase with a total estimated construction cost of \$3.19 billion. Of those 49 projects, 24 are ARP Projects and 25 are Core Program Projects; however, this does not include the 51 projects that have reached substantial completion and are currently in the Building Complete Phase. The 25 Core Program Projects have a total estimated construction cost of \$3.15 billion and are listed below.

Amendment to the Project Funding Agreement (PFA)

Upon receipt of construction bids or the execution of a GMP, a district submits the Contractor's Schedule of Values to the MSBA. MSBA staff will collaborate with the district to reconcile the construction costs from the schedule of values against the estimated construction budget. Afterwards, an amendment to the PFA is executed to reflect the bids received for those projects. The chart, shown below, is the number of amendments to PFAs listed by fiscal year.

Substantial Completion

Eight projects were scheduled to reach Substantial Completion in 2020. They are listed in the table below. The MSBA has received executed certificates for seven of the eight projects, shown below, and anticipates receipt of the final certificate (Braintree). For Somerville, the Substantial Completion Date as defined by the Construction Contract is reportedly under review by the District; therefore, the variance is labeled "Pending". Staff will continue to monitor these projects for updates.

CLOSEOUT

After the district's contractor finishes all project work including, demolishing the old building, completing site work, and finalizing commissioning, the project proceeds to the Closeout Phase. Once all the project costs have been paid by the District, the District submits its Final Request for Payment Reimbursement via the MSBA's Pro-Pay system. After the District submits all the items identified on the MSBA's Index of Final Closeout, including the Final Request for Payment Reimbursement, the MSBA initiates the Draft Audit Report and sends it to the District for its consideration. The MSBA performs the final audit to determine final total grant amounts. Final payment to the District requires the MSBA Board's approval of the final Total Facilities Grant for the project.

Currently, there are 78 projects in the Closeout Phase including 56 ARP Projects and 22 Core Program Projects. The chart, shown below, lists the Core Program Projects by year of achieved Substantial Completion:

The photos above depict the before and after of the window replacement at Boston's Donald McKay School, serving 742 students. The project replaced the windows, thus extending the useful life of the 95-year-old building. The project reached Substantial Completion in December 2017 and is scheduled to receive Final Audit Approval at the December 15, 2021 Board of Directors meeting.


Currently, there are 176 ARP projects in the MSBA's Eligibility Period and Capital Pipeline. 











Accelerated Repair Projects – Schedule Extension Update

The MSBA has granted districts conditional extensions to their PFAs pending compliance with the following stipulations:

- The district must submit a detailed, revised, construction timeline that explains how the work will be completed at each school; and
- Any costs that are related to a district requesting an extension to the construction schedule will be the sole responsibility of the district, and those costs are categorically ineligible for reimbursement by the MSBA.

Schedule delays for these districts can be attributed to local funding issues, lead time for windows, and construction delays on site. In no event have the extended schedules resulted in an increase to the Estimated Maximum Total Facilities Grant, as authorized by the Board.

Two of the 30 2018 ARP Projects revised their construction schedules to reflect substantial completion in 2021 or beyond. Staff has reported previously on the shaded projects listed below, which remain in Construction or Design Development.

Information is presented noting postponements and extensions provided to districts in Eligibility Period and Feasibility Study as well as extensions provided to districts to seek local funding approval. Staff has reported this information at previous Board meetings. All the new information that has been updated since the last report is *italicized and bolded*.

District Postponements and Extensions – Core Program

The table below notes three of the 11 2019 SOIs have requested postponements to their originally scheduled commencement dates for Eligibility Period. In addition, five of the 12 2017 SOIs have requested extensions to their feasibility study and schematic design schedules. Projects shaded below have completed the described milestone. *Medfield was unable to appropriate its local funding and has submitted its request to be removed from the Capital Pipeline at the December 15, 2021 Board of Directors meeting.*
