

Model School Program History

- Pilot Program initiated in 2008
- Incentive reimbursement points removed at the March 16, 2016 Board of Directors meeting
- Total of 12 model schools approved at the July 20, 2016 Board of Directors meeting
- Original 16 model schools removed at the November 9, 2016 Board of Directors meeting
- Additional 2 models approved at the February 11, 2021 Board of Directors meeting
- Additional 6 models approved at the October 27, 2021 Board of Directors meeting
- Removal of 2 model schools at the December 21, 2022 Board of Directors meeting

Model School Program Summary

- Current inventory includes 20 approved model schools:
 - 12 Elementary Schools
 - 2 Middle Schools
 - 1 MS/HS
 - 5 High Schools
- Purpose of Request For Qualifications (RFQ) update model schools by selecting one or more existing schools of various grade configurations



- Of the 16 districts that have participated in MSBA's Designer Selection Panel since January 2022, 12 indicated potential interest in the Model School Program in their Designer Request for Services
- Additionally, since January 2023, 1 district has completed the Model School selection process and executed a contract with a Model School designer




2023 RFQ Minimum Requirements:

- Must be all new, PK-12 construction, located within a 125-mile radius of Worcester
- Permitted under MA Code 9th edition or later, or if not in MA, under the IECC 2015 & ASHRAE 90.1 2013
- Open for full occupancy for minimum of 12 months as of September 15, 2023
- Registered with USGBC "LEED-S" or MA / NE-CHPS

RFQ Evaluation Process:

- Phase 1 Review:
 - Contact person: Siobhan Tolman
 - Completed by Legal Department
 - Review to ensure responses meet submittal requirements in RFQ
- Phase 2 Initial Assessment of Responses:
 - Completed by Selection Committee
 - Review proposed model schools meeting threshold requirements using evaluation criteria in RFQ
- Phase 2 School Visits:
 - Completed by Selection Committee
- Phase 3 Review
 - Staff complete evaluation and present recommendations to MSBA Board

Model School Program RFQ

RFQ Evaluation Criteria:

- Adaptable to other sites
- Adaptable to a 20% +/- design enrollment
- Adaptable to variations in educational programs
- Flexibility for multiple and/or future uses
- Includes differentiated learning / collaboration areas
- Conforms to MSBA space standards
- Incorporates energy efficiency / sustainable design elements
- Environmental qualities and natural lighting
- Complies with the MSBA Guidelines for Science Labs
- Construction cost per SF, soft costs & change orders
